NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

In order to effectuate the said object of creating and establishing a public charitable Trust, the "SETTLOR" is desirous of alleviating the suffering and attaining upliftment of the common masses in the society, he has decided to create a public charitable trust and the Settlor is seized and possessed of or otherwise well and sufficient either to the land and ~~situated~~ situated at Mouze: Bagesarai, P.S.: Gazole, Dist.: Malda and more particularly described in the Schedule hereunder written. The Settlor desires to settle the said property on Trusts hereinafter appearing. The Trustees have, at the request of the Settlor, agreed to act as the First Trustees of the said Trusts and these presents. The Settlor desires to transfer the said property to the Trustees on the execution of these presents to be held by the Trustees on Trusts and subject to the powers and provisions hereinafter contained. That in consideration of the premises and in order to effectuate the said desire of the Settlor and for diverse other good cause and considerations, the Settlor doth hereby grant or transfer unto the Trustees the said property described in the Schedule hereunder written together with all buildings and structures forming part of the said property and together with all the easements and rights, liberties and privileges appurtenant thereto and all the estate, right, title and interest of the Settlor into and upon the property To Have And To Hold the same unto the Trustees to the use and upon the Trusts and with subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter declared and contained of and concerning the same, to being with for extending humanitarian services in all their form and substance to the needy, oppressed deserving and promising indian citizen who are in dire need of education, economical, medical and moral upliftment.

The constitution or instrument of the Trust shall be as under :-

1. NAME : The name of the (public charitable) trust hereby established shall always be "ADARSHABANI MISSION" and the same name shall never be changed.
2. OFFICE : The principal office of the Trust shall be at VILL & P.O.: GAZOLE, P.S: Gazole, DIST.: MALDA, (W.B.)- 732124.
3. JURISDICTION : The jurisdiction of the Trust shall be throughout India.
4. AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE TRUST SHALL BE :

- a. Education is master-key by which we can unlock all unsolved problems. Lack of proper education and training leads to a crisis of morals that we are facing trouble to progress a nation, economy, literacy, health and in the field of games and sports, also making grievance among Cast, Creed and race. Only education can conquer these crisis.
- b. Education is a master key to answer hundreds of thousands questions we may have in the universe, those are related to nature, life, people, civilization, co-existence, society and its reformation, liberty, unity in diversity, equality, neighborhood, duty and responsibilities, knowledge, truth, consciousness etc. and relationship among each other.
- c. Further we believe on the Philosophy of education of Swami Vivekananda who formulated ultimate aim of education in a brief; as it is - " We want that education by which character is formed, strength of mind is increased the intellect is expanded and by which one can stand one's own feet."

And

"The end of all education, all training, should be man-making. The end and Aim of all training is to make the man grow.

It is man-making religion that we want.
It is man-making theories that we want.
It is man-making education all round that we want."

- d. Depending upon this philosophical thought the institute wish to serve the society with highest level of ethics, honesty and responsibility toward the nation.

To acquire, establish, starts, aid run maintain or manage educational institution libraries educational and training instructions for minorities for females and also for all people in general of the society, specially any primary school, and other educational institution, necessary approval, affiliation permission etc will be obtained from the govt. or other appropriate authorities.

- h. To educate children of different age group.
- i. To establish charitable hospital for weaker and needy portion of people.

The trustees shall be entitled and shall have liberty to accept gift, voluntary contributions from any person, firm or institution of Government and to collect subscription, donation or aid from state Government, central Government to augment the trust fund and use such money for the objects of the trust.
- P. To look after bound animals and to protect environment and wild life.
- Q. To collect and preserve manuscripts, painting sculptures work of arts, Antiquities, natural history specimens, mechanical and scientific Instruments and design.
- R. To maintain the standard & status of education; innovative, creative and fundamental laws of education will be applied.
- S. To establish, promote, set-up, run, maintain, assist, finance, support and / or aid or help in the setting up and / or maintaining and / or running / awareness program for welfare of man in different training programs both technical and non-technical.

The financial year of the trust shall end on 31st March every year, provided that the board of Trustees shall be liberty to change the same from time to time if they so deem it fit and proper.

The trustees shall from time to time, after meeting the expenses of and incidental to the management of the Trust Properties and of the trust, decide the particular objects for which the income or corpus of the Trust fund or properties for the time being available, shall be applied.

The trustees may accept any donation or contribution in cash or in kind from any, firm company, corporation, association, institution or trust (including the settlor or the trustees or any of them) for the furtherance of the objects of the trust or for any one or more of them upon such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and which are not inconsistent with the object of the trust. The trustees may also take over the management of any other charitable or public institutions or such terms as they deem fit and may manage such institutions.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The administration, management and control of the Trust and its properties shall vest in the hands of committee to be called the Board of Trustees, consisting of three persons for the time being.

1. The first Trustees of Trust who have accepted to be the Trustees shall be as below :-

The Trustees shall hold office during their life unless any of them desires to be discharged of his duties or becomes mentally or physically incapable of working or is declared insolvent or is convicted of a criminal offence.

In the event of a vacancy arising in the Board of Trustees for whatever reasons, the remaining Trustees shall co-opt another major male or female person out of the family members of that person to fill up the vacancy.

The number of Trustees shall at no time be less than two (2) and more than seven (7).

The Trustees shall work in an honorary capacity, but they shall be entitled to reimburse expenses incurred by them in the conduct of their duties or in promotion of the objects of the Trust or on behalf of the Trust. No Trustee shall be entitled to take loan from the Trust or to take any advantage for himself or any member of his family in whatever form or manner from the Trust.

A Trustee who by his conduct as a Trustee or in his personal life adversely reflects on the reputation of the Trust may be asked by the Board of Trustees by a resolution passed by a majority to submit his resignation, failing which he shall cease to be a Trustee with effect from the date of passing of such resolution.

To make, vary, alter modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects thereof and for running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.

To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institution for the benefit of general public and impose any condition to any subscription or donation made by them.

To set apart or accumulate the whole or part of the income or corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any subscription or donation made by them.

The Trustees may appoint secretaries, managers, lawyers, solicitors, auditors, architects, engineers, surveyors, social workers, doctor, nurse, paramedics, clerks, accountants, project directors, or other employees for the purpose of management and supervision of the Trust Estate, for collection of rents, public works, welfare activities, effects and profits for keeping the accounts and records for other purpose of the trust.

The Trustees shall cause true and accurate accounts to be kept of all moneys received and spent and of all matters in respect thereof in course of management of trust properties or in relation to the carrying out of the objects and purpose of the trust, as well as of all the assets credits and effects of the trust properties.

The Trustees may invest the Trust Estate either in the purchase of immovable properties or of mortgage of immovable properties, or in such manner as allowed by law as may be in force from time to time and to convert, alter, vary, dispose of or transfer such investments from time to time, provided that such investment shall not be mad which are directly or indirectly for the benefit of any person referred to in sub. Sec. (3) of Sec. 13 or the income Tax Act, 1961 or any subsequent amendments as may be made from time to time.

if the income from the trust property in a particular year is not fully utilized, the unexpended income subject to the applicable provisions of the income Tax Act, 1961, shall be carried over to the next year or years and spent in such subsequent or years for the advancement of any of the objects of the trust.

The Trustees shall be at liberty to sell such portion or portions of the movable or immovable properties forming part of the trust estate either by public auction or private contract at such price or prices and in such terms and conditions relating to title or otherwise in all respects as they may in their absolute discretion think fit and to rescind or vary any contract for the sale thereof and to resell the same without being answerable for any loss occasioned thereby and to execute all conveyances or other assurances and to pass valid and effectual receipts and discharges for all moneys received by them.

The trustees shall keep and account or accounts with any nationalized bank or banks, to operate such account or accounts whether in debit or credit and to give all appropriate instructions to the banker or bankers concerning the operation of such account or accounts and to authorize by appropriate resolution two or more of the trustees jointly / separately with an agent appointed by the Board of Trustees in this behalf to operate such account or accounts.

The Trustees may institute, conduct, defend, compound or abandon any legal procedure by or against the Trust or Trustees and allow time and indulgence for payment or satisfaction of any debt due or for any claims or demands by or against the Trust.

The Trustees of the Trust may obtain payments of money from all Courts and Departments of the State and Central Governments including local authority or authorities.

The Trustees may purchase, construct, alter, lease, rent partly or fully immovable or movable property from time to time. They shall have power to sell movable or immovable property of the Trust by two third of the majority in the best interest of the Trust as and when necessary and to use these proceeds for the objects of the Trust only.

The Trustees may authorize any of the Trustees to appear before the registrar or sub registrar or any other officials appointed for registration of deeds, documents and other instruments and to execute, present, admit and register or cause to be registered any deed, documents etc. in which the Trust is interested or involved.

The Trustees shall be empowered to employ whole time or full time or part time servants, clerks, doctors, nurses, technicians and other professionals and personnel according to the requirement of various institutions that may from time to time be run or established by the Trust on such norms and conditions as the Trust may decide from time to time. The Trustees shall have power to accept honorary services of any person volunteering to do the work in the Trust or in the charitable institutions run by the Trust. The Trustees shall have full disciplinary control and powers over such staff, employees, workers honorary or otherwise.

MEETINGS

- a. The Trustees may meet together as and when they may think necessary. But they shall hold at least two meetings in a year.
- b. The quorum at a meeting of the Trustees shall be of two, when the strength of the Trustees is Three. The quorum shall be three if the strength is more than four.

- c. Ashutosh Sarkar shall preside over all meetings of the Trust. In case he is not present, the Trustees present may elect one of them as Chairman of that meeting.

The Trustees shall act according to the decisions of the majority of the Trustees. When the Trustees are not unanimous the Chairman shall have the casting vote in case of a tie.

- d. There will be no need of a quorum for adjourned meeting wherein agenda of last meeting will be discussed or decided.
- e. A resolution passed by circulation by the majority of the Trustees shall be valid and effective as a resolution passed at a meeting of Trustees.

FINANCIAL YEAR : The financial year of the Trust shall commence from 1st April and close on 31st March of every year.

BANK ACCOUNT : The Trustees shall open bank account or accounts in the name of the Trust in any nationalized bank which will be operated by joint signatures of the Chairman and one of the two Trustees authorized by the Board of Trustees.

ACCOUNTS AND AUDITS : The Trustees shall maintain proper accounts. They will be annually audited by chartered accountant appointed by the Board of Trustees fixing his remuneration.

DISSOLUTION : In the unfortunate event of the aforesaid objects being incapable of carrying into effect, the Trustees may divert the funds of the Trust to any other appropriate charitable purpose as per cy-pres doctrine.

We once again confirm that the above decision is irrevocably binding upon us or our heirs and successors.

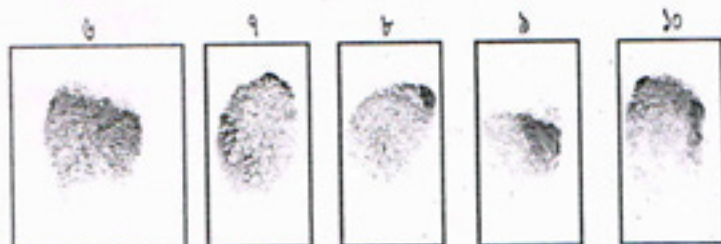
